*Video making:*

Evaluation:

It is very important that you look up the vocabulary needed for your presentation and the pronunciation you can check it in [www.wordreference.com](http://www.wordreference.com). You need to use the appropriate verb tense for what you are talking, for example: If your topic is morning routine you will use simple present

Use realia, show elements around you to support your ideas, move around act and mind your performance.

Practice your pronunciation, listen carefully to yourself, if you need to record several times do so.

Enunciate the words, you need to be understood for instance speak looking straight to the camera don't cover your mouth and remember to repeat hard words over and over again until they are easy to pronounce.
