We use the PRESENT



PERFECT to talk about our

*experiences in life: EX: I have studied in 3 different schools

*to talk about actions that have a present result: EX : Somebody has stolen my scooter, it has disappeared! (que sucedió recientemente)

*To talk about actions starting in the past and going on in the present

EX: My dad has worked hard all his life.

We use Have + verb in past participle (affirmative)

Have+ not (negative) or haven't

1. PUT the verb in brackets in the affirmative form of the present perfect

1. She----- (live) in England all her life.
2. They------(play) in many movies.
3. She -----(just /win) a huge sum of money on the lottery.
4. David -----(finish) typing his report.
5. Look! Somebody -----(steal) statue in the park.
